

REPORT OF BAIL VIOLATIONS

Reference is made to a Status Report previously submitted on November 13, 2009. On November 29, 2007. On November 23, 2009, the above-named defendant appeared before Your Honor and pled guilty to two counts of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1343, wire fraud, and one count of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1957, engaging in unlawful monetary transactions. He was ordered released under the same conditions of release that had been previously imposed, which included the use of a location monitoring device (electronic monitoring).

It is noted that the Court granted the defendant permission to travel to the Southern District of Florida to reside in the custody of his mother and step-father, Karen and Henry (Hank) Goelz, from November 24, 2009 through January 8, 2010. Due to the order allowing the defendant to briefly reside in Boca Raton, Florida, supervision was transferred to the Southern District of Florida.

On November 25, 2009, the defendant reported to the U.S. Probation Office in West Palm Beach, Florida as instructed. The defendant was instructed to stay and remain at home until contacted by an officer for the installation of the location monitoring equipment. On December 1, 2009, a home visit to the defendant's residence was conducted for the purpose of installing the equipment. The defendant was not home and his step-father, Harold Goelz, advised that the defendant and his wife went to their home in Weston, Florida to pick up some things from this residence. The defendant was contacted and returned 45 minutes later. When questioned by officers about his whereabouts and lack of permission to leave the residence, the defendant indicated that his attorney had given him permission to leave his residence and go to their home in Weston.



On December 2, 2009, the defendant submitted a urine specimen which tested positive for the presence of Cocaine, Opiates, Benzodiazepine, and Amphetamines in the Southern District of Florida's local laboratory. This test has been send out for confirmation by Kroll Laboratory Specialist, Inc.


I am reporting these violations as required by 18 U.S.C. § 3154(5). Based upon the defendant's failure to follow the instructions of the United States Pretrial Services office, and his continued use of controlled substances, Mr. Healy appears to present an ongoing risk of danger to the community and a risk of nonappearance. By copy of this memorandum, I am advising the Government of the violation and request that a sealed warrant be issued and the defendant be required to show cause as to why his bail should not be revoked.

REPORT OF BAIL VIOLATIONS

On October 15, 2009, the above-named defendant appeared before U.S. Magistrate Judge Carlson for an initial appearance. He was ordered released on a secured bond, to reside at 33 Wintercress Lane, West Northport, New York, with a third party custodian, his stepfather Harold Goelz, on pretrial services supervision with electronic monitoring. Among others, special conditions of release require that the defendant participate in substance abuse evaluation, testing and/or treatment as directed by pretrial services. Due to the third party custodian's residence in New York, supervision was transferred to the Eastern District of New York.

During the bail interview, Mr. Healy reported that his last use of illicit drugs occurred six months ago. Following his initial appearance, the defendant submitted to a drug test, and lab results showed the presences of cocaine. On November 4, 2009, the defendant provided an additional sample which tested positive for cocaine (confirmed by the lab).

I am reporting this violation as required by 18 U.S.C. § 3154(5). Based upon the defendant's failure to be truthful during the bail interview, and his continued use of narcotics while on electronic monitoring, Mr. Healy appears to present an ongoing risk of danger to the community and a risk of nonappearance. By copy of this memorandum, I am advising the Government of the violation and request that a warrant be issued and the defendant be required to show cause as to why his bail should not be revoked.
